FINANCIAL SUPPORT:

Funding under a 2+2 project is in the form of Grant-in-aid to both Indian and German Project Partners. The maximum funding to German partners is amounting to Euro 500.000 and Indian partners limited to Rs. 350 lakhs per project for a period of three years.
