ABOUT THE GRANT



The Zayed Sustainability Prize is the UAE's pioneering global award that recognises and rewards small to medium sized enterprises (SMEs), nonprofit organisations (NPOs), and global high schools with impactful, innovative, and inspiring sustainable solutions.

CATEGORIES



1. HEALTH

Recognises organisations with innovative, impactful and inspirational sustainability solutions in the areas of health.

Eligible: SMEs or NPOs

PRIZE FUND: US \$1,000,000



2. FOOD

Recognises organisations with innovative, impactful and inspirational sustainability solutions in the areas of food.

Eligible: SMEs or NPOs

PRIZE FUND: US \$1,000,000



3. ENERGY

Recognises organisations with innovative, impactful and inspirational sustainability solutions in the areas of energy.

Eligible: SMEs or NPOs

PRIZE FUND: US \$1,000,000



4. WATER

Recognises organisations with innovative, impactful and inspirational sustainability solutions in the areas of water.

Eligible: SMEs or NPOs

PRIZE FUND: US \$1,000,000



5. CLIMATE ACTION

Recognises organisations with innovative, impactful and inspirational solutions producing positive results in climate action.

Eligible: SMEs or NPOs

PRIZE FUND: US \$1,000,000



6. GLOBAL HIGH SCHOOLS

Recognises high schools or secondary schools from six global geographic regions that propose innovative, impactful and inspirational sustainability projects in the areas of health, food, energy and/or water. The project could be in one area or a combination of areas (e.g. health, food, energy, water and climate action).
